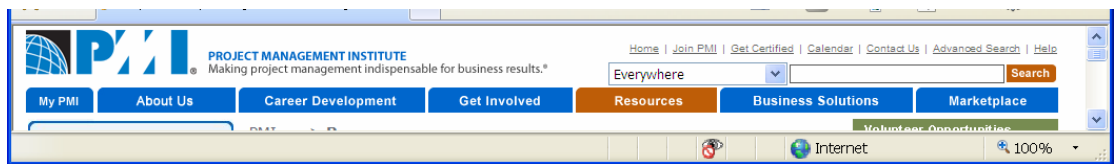


Downloading PMI Standards from the website:

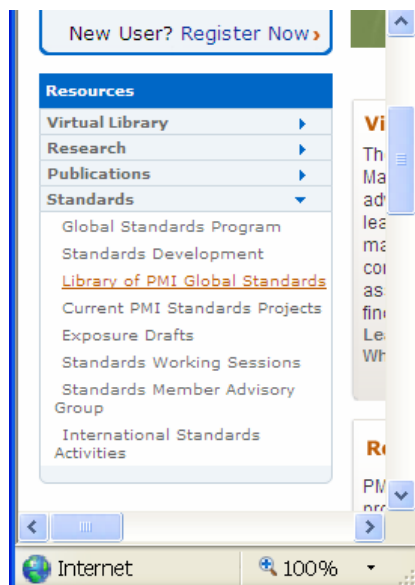
1. Go to www.pmi.org

3. After logging in, click on the 'Resources' tab




4. On the Resources screen, select 'Standards' and then 'Library of PMI Global Standards' (from the left hand side of the screen)



Now in its third edition, *A Guide to the Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK® Guide)* is regarded as one of the profession's most essential resources — a global standard for the industry. It can help project management practitioners prepare for credential examinations, or assist organizations in creating and shaping their project management system. The *PMBOK® Guide* is not designed to function as a step-by-step how-to book, but rather to identify that subset of the project management body of knowledge that is generally recognized as good practices.

The *PMBOK® Guide* has been recognized by several well-respected organizations, including the American National Standards Institute, the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers and the International Organization for Standardization Technical Report.
