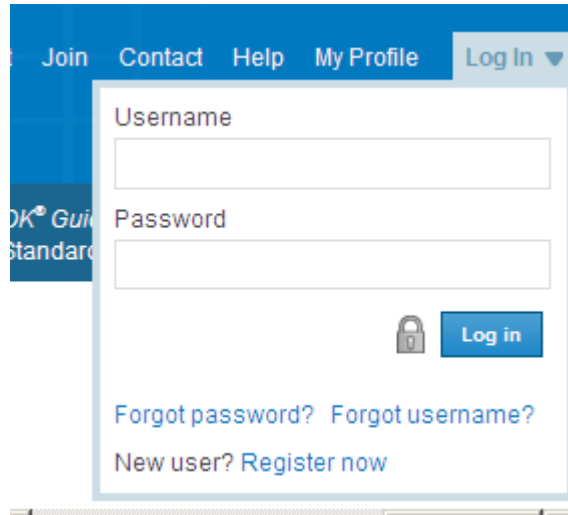
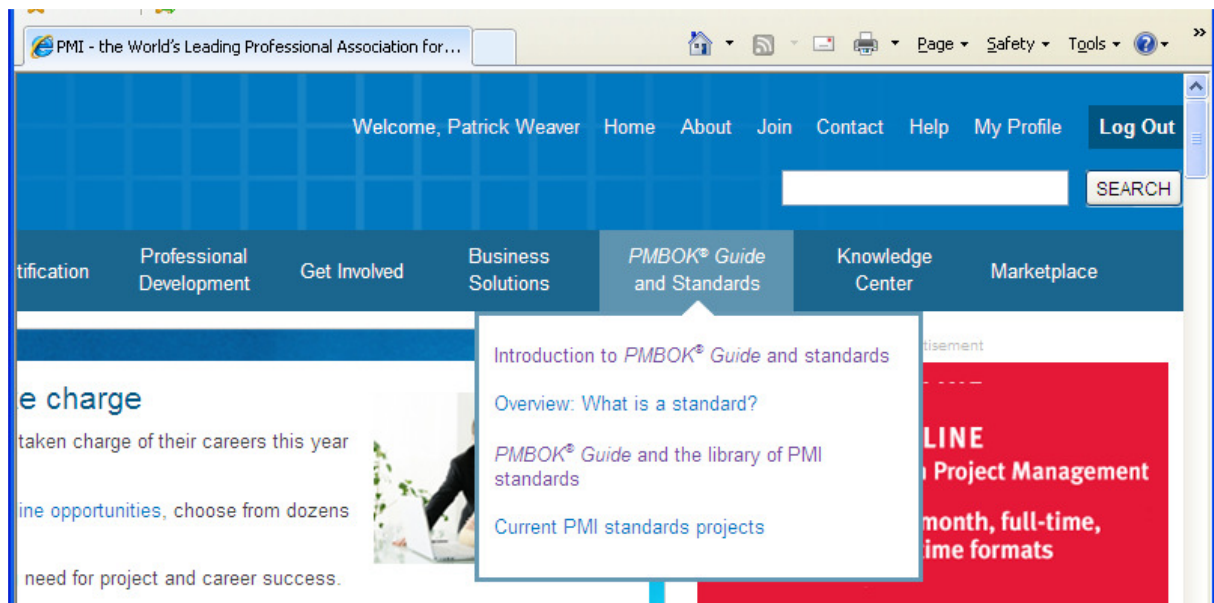


## Downloading PMI Standards from the website:
